# Local Government Domain

A domain name is part of a URL (Uniform Resource Locator) is the address of a World Wide Web page. Security Certificate Included.

Examples:

- AllenCounty.IN.gov
- TownofSandborn.IN.gov
- CityofElkhart.IN.gov

Why an IN.gov domain?

- Free SSL certificate
- Security and brand recognition of the IN.gov Program
- Federal Grant money - easier to apply for with an IN.gov domain
- Can be used with MX records for IN.gov email address

- Multiple templates allowing for customization
- Full control of content with easy to use, no code Content Management System
- Access to 3<sup>rd</sup> Party tools, such as Google Analytics, Siteimprove, and more
- Responsive Design, 508 Compliance, and Security
- Full hosting by IN.gov – technical support, no downtime, MHA and DR included
