Procurement Standards 200.318(a-b)



 Must use its own documented procurement procedures which reflect applicable state and local laws and regulations.

Procurement Standards 200.318 (c)



- Must maintain written standards of conduct covering conflicts of interest and governing
- the actions of its employees engaged in the selection, award and administration of contracts.
- No employee, officer or agent may participate in the selection, award, or administration of a
- contract if there is a conflict of interest.
- No employee, officer or agent may neither solicit nor accept gratuities, favors or anything of
- monetary value from contractors or parties to subcontractors. Standards may be set.

State Requirements

- Public Purchases IC 5-22
- Does not apply to public works project
 - There are exceptions

IC 5-22-3-3 allows a county to adopt rules to regulate purchases to supplement but may not be inconsistent with IC 5-22

PUBLIC WORKS LAW IC 36-1-12

• IC 36-1-12-2:

 "As used in this chapter, "public work" means the construction, reconstruction, alteration, or renovation of a public building, airport facility, or other structure that is paid for out of a public fund or out of a special assessment. The term includes the construction, alteration, or repair of a highway, street, alley, bridge, sewer, drain, or other improvement that is paid for out of a public fund or out of a special assessment. The term also includes any public work leased by a political subdivision under a lease containing an option to purchase."

PUBLIC WORKS LAW IC 36-1-12

- Exceptions to IC 36-1-12
 - •IC 36-1-12-3 Using your own workforce
 - Use IC 5-22 for purchase of supplies
 - •IC 361-12-49 Routine repairs and maintenance costing less than \$150,000
 - May use IC 5-22

PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

* STATE &

•Small Projects < \$50,000

•\$50,000 < Project cost > \$150,000

•Project Cost > \$150,000

PROJECTS LESS THAN \$50,000

- •IC 36-1-12-5
 - Can bid the project
 - Can invite quotes
 - If all quotes rejected can negotiate
 - Special consideration for resurfacing projects

PROJECTS BETWEEN \$50,000 & \$150,000

- Board must invite quotes from at least 3 persons known to deal in the class of work proposed.
 - Must mail a notice of plans and specification for least 7 days before receiving quotes.
- Meeting to receive quotes must be open to the public and read aloud.
 - Cannot require quotes to be submitted before meeting.
- Must award to lower responsible and responsive bidder.
 - May reject all quotes if documented reasons for rejecting.

PROJECTS > \$150,000

- Board must prepare general plans and specifications.
 - Must avoid specifications that may limit competition.
 - Plans must be filed in a public location.
- Public notice of sealed bids.
 - Must state time and place.
 - If < \$25,000,000 notice must be at least 6 weeks before opening.
 - If > \$25,000,000 notice must be at least 10 weeks before opening.
- Items required from submitters:
 - Financial Statements, statement of experience, proposed plan, equipment available for use.
 - Affidavit that bidder has not agreed to prevent/set/induce bid
