

**CVSO Employment Requirements:** 

**IC 10-17-1-9** (c) If the remuneration and expenses of a county or city service officer are paid from the funds of the county or city employing the service officer, the service officer shall:

(1) have the same qualifications and be subject to the same rules as the director, assistant director, and state service officers of the Indiana department of veterans' affairs; and

(2) serve under the supervision of the director of veterans' affairs.

A <u>service officer assistant</u> must have the same qualifications as an employee described in section 11(b) of this chapter.





## **CVSO Employment Requirements:**

### CVSO:

#### IC 10-17-1-5 Director of veterans' affairs

Sec. 5. (a) The position of director of veterans' affairs is established. The governor shall appoint the director for a four (4) year term. However, the term of office of the director terminates when the term of office of the governor terminates or when a successor to the director is appointed and qualified. The director must be: (1) an honorably discharged veteran who has at least six (6) months active service in the armed forces of the United States; and (2) a citizen of Indiana and a resident of Indiana for at least five (5) years immediately preceding the director's appointment.

## ACVSO:

IC 10-17-1-11 (b)(2) be the spouse, surviving spouse, parent, or child of a person who satisfies; the requirements set forth in section 5(a) of this chapter.

**Benefits of full time CVSO office hours:** 

CVSO office open same as ALL other county offices

- Veteran's are equally important to the county
- Welcome walk-ins, unplanned visit

Little to no Wait Time

Less likely to return if long wait

□Community Outreach Efforts – DSO and CVSO

Warm hand-offs, both ways – hard to send to closed office

Many benefits are time sensitive, important to see veteran asap





Full time CVSO office hours & Proper staffing

### **Benefits of CVSO support staff**

- □ Keep wait time down
- □Input veteran in VetraSpec and make appointment(s)
- Provide CVSO to do home visits for homebound veterans
- □Keeps office open for CVSO to attend/create outreach
- Keeps office open for CVSO to expand service area; CBOC/Legion type hours

Veteran and dependent compensation is tax-free monthly payment directly to the claimant


Compensation is dispersed into the county economy

## Full time CVSO office hours & Proper staffing

### Maintain VA Accreditation

#### IC 10-17-1-10Training courses; service officers

(c) An individual employed as a county, or city service officer under this chapter is **required to become accredited by a national veterans service organization through the United States Department of Veterans Affairs** Office of General Counsel not later than one (1) year from the date of individual's employment, in order to represent veterans.

§ 14.629 Requirements for accreditation of service organization representatives; agents; and attorneys.
 (2) Is either a member in good standing or a paid employee of such organization working for it not less than 1,000 hours (Authority: 38 U.S.C. 501(a), 5902)
